

**Progress Review Meeting of Ganges River Dolphin - Conservation

**A Report**

One day progress review meeting of Ganges River Dolphin- conservation education programme was organized by Centre for Environment Education (CEE) with the support from National Mission for Clean Ganga. The purpose of the Progress Review Meeting was to assess and measure the progress of partner NGOs of Uttar Pradesh and Bihar working on Ganges River Dolphin - Conservation Education Programme. Kanaujia (Regional Coordinator, CEE-North, Lucknow ) made a presentation on Centre for Environment Education (CEE) and the kind of work they are doing in UP and Bihar for conservation of Ganges Dolphin. Mr. P.K. Sarkar and Ms. Divya spoke about the initiatives and efforts of UP State Ganga River Conservation Agency. All partner NGOs made

presentations on Dolphin School Cluster initiatives and activities by undertaken in Uttar Pradesh and Bihar.

As the gathering had representations (partner NGOs) from the field, UPSGRCA availed this opportunity and did the pre-testing of Radio Spot based on Ganga Conservation. During the meeting SGRCA and CEE team tried to find out the possible ways for partnership to work with the children in the State especially in Allahabad, Varanasi and Kanpur. In this regard a meeting has to be fixed between SGRCA and CEE which would be organised once Ms. Kanaujia is returned from tour next week. Once the meeting happens with CEE then only possible areas may be worked out.
